Dear colleagues!

We invite you to participate in the **“IV International Forum Priority scientific and pedagogical directions for the development of physical education, sport, tourism, education and science”** and the **IV International Scientific and Practical Conference “Actual issues of physical education, sport, tourism and education”**, which will be held on April 9–10, 2026, at the Kazakh Academy of Sport and Tourism in Almaty.

The annual International Forum is a professional platform for exchanging scientific and practical experience in the fields of physical culture, sports, tourism, education, and related branches of science within the framework of roundtables and the international conference. The event brings together scientists, educators, coaches, representatives of educational institutions, and the business community.

The purpose of the forum is to promote the formation of professional dialogue, the development of scientific schools, and the implementation of advanced practices in the system of physical culture, sports, tourism, and education.

Forum Events:

- ✓ April 9, 2026 – Roundtable on the topic: “Modern Approaches to the Development of Adaptive Physical Culture (APC) and Sports.”
- ✓ April 9, 2026 – Roundtable on the topic: “Sports Games in the System of Physical Education for Students”.
- ✓ April 9, 2026 – Masterclasses on National Sports.
- ✓ April 9, 2026 – Martial Arts Festival.
- ✓ April 10, 2026 – Sectional sessions and the plenary session of the IV International Scientific and Practical Conference “Actual issues of physical education, sport, tourism and education”.

Main areas of the conference:

1. Modern scientific and pedagogical foundations, language competencies, and technologies for training personnel in the fields of physical education, sports, and tourism (analysis of labor market requirements, dual education, development of soft skills for future specialists, etc.);
2. Inclusive physical culture and adaptive sports: challenges, trends, and development directions;
3. Digitalization of education and training processes, as well as the digital transformation of the sports industry: research, development, and implementation of IT solutions, online platforms, and gamification technologies;
4. Traditional games and sports of nomadic people: cultural heritage, social stability, and transformation in the context of globalization;
5. Training personnel for tourism in the context of geoeconomic changes and regional integration of Central Asia;

6. Integration of tourism with the creative economy (event industry, film tourism, digital content, festival tourism).

Conference participation formats:

- With a report and publication of an article, including online participation;
- With a report without publication of an article, including online participation;
- Without a report, with publication of an article.

• **Time limit:** up to 10 minutes per presentation.

• **Working languages of the conference:** Kazakh, Russian, English.

Conference Presentation Requirements

The report should reflect the main content of the independent research. The introductory part of the report must present the aim and research problem. The main part should include the theoretical and practical findings of the research. The concluding part should provide a conclusion in accordance with the stated research objectives. Presentation duration – up to 10 minutes. A computer presentation is mandatory.

Conference participants are expected to answer questions from participants of the sections and plenary.

Following the conference, a collection of scientific works will be compiled in electronic format and subsequently posted on the website of the Kazakh Academy of Sports and Tourism. The Organizing Committee emphasizes that the originality of the article texts must be at least 60%. Materials submitted to the conference are not peer-reviewed and are published in the authors' original format. Works that do not meet the specified requirements or have not passed plagiarism check (anti-plagiarism) will not be accepted for publication.

To participate in the conference, by March 27, 2026, it is necessary to:

- ✓ Fill out the application form for conference participation;
- ✓ If participating with publication, send the article formatted according to the **Article Formatting Requirements** to the email address listed on the scientific forum website. The email subject should be “Conference Participant,” and the file in .doc or .docx format must be named with the author's surname, for example, “Ahmetov_article.”

Organizational fee for conference participants – 5000 KZT (or equivalent in Russian rubles, US dollars, or Euros).

Payment for participation is made after receiving the acceptance notification of the submitted materials, with detailed information on payment methods. When making a payment, indicate “Conference Participant” and include your full name.

Travel, accommodation, and meal expenses are covered by the sending organization.

REQUIREMENTS FOR FORMATTING SUBMITTED MATERIALS

ATTENTION! The file name must include the participant's surname and the direction number (for an article – article_Ahmetov S.S.; for the application – application_Ahmetov S.S.).

Only original materials not previously published in other printed or electronic publications are accepted for publication in the collection.

Materials must be prepared using the software capabilities of Microsoft Word with the extension .doc (.docx), font Times New Roman, font size 14, margins 2.0 cm on all sides, indentation - 1.25 cm (indentation with using the "space" and "tab" keys), spacing 1.15, text alignment in width. Compacting intervals is prohibited. Initials in the text and links are connected to the surname using a “non-breaking space” - I. I. Ivanov). The volume of materials is up to 5 pages in A4 format.

Line-by-line design of materials:

1. UDC (in capitals, left aligned, font size 14 pt);

In the language of the article, font size 12 pt:

2. Article title (in capital letters, bold, centered,

3. Initials, author's surname, academic degree, academic title, position (centered alignment);

4. Organization name (in full), city and country (centered alignment);

5. The abstract should include a description of the main topic, the problem of the scientific article, the goals of the work, and its results. Abstract length up to 120 words (justified);

6. Key words. The recommended number of words is from 5 to 7 (justified).

In English, font size 12 pt:

Article title (in capital letters, bold, left aligned);

Initials, author's surname, organization name (in full), city and country (justified);

Abstract... (justified);

Key words.... (width alignment).

7. The design of the list of references. A list of references (5 to 7 sources) is required, designed by GOST P 7.0.5-2008, TimesNewRoman font, size 12.

8. The text may include graphic images and tables in black and white, for which it is necessary to indicate their location in the article with links, for example - Fig. 1, Fig. 2, and Table 1 in Word format.

9. The originality of the text when analyzed in the Anti-Plagiarism system is at least 60%.

10. Responsibility for the quality of translation into English of individual parts of the article lies with the author of the publication; the use of automatic machine and online text translators is unacceptable.

11. Articles received by the organizing committee later than **March 27, 2026**, or that do not meet the listed requirements will not be published.
