Leading scientists and specialists in the field of physical culture and sports will take part in the conference; teachers and young scientists of universities, undergraduates and doctoral students; administrators, methodologists and teachers of educational organizations, children's and youth sports schools, schools of higher sports mastery, etc.

**The purpose of the conference** is to exchange the experience of foreign and domestic experts in the field of development of boxing, weightlifting, martial arts, and the national martial arts Bel-Bilek Combat.

**The main directions of the conference**

The conference will be organized in the main areas and current problems in the development of boxing, weightlifting, martial arts, and the national martial arts Bel-Bilek Combat, assessing prospects and new approaches in the methodology of training specialists, taking into account the integration of education and the training process.

**Form and venue of the conference:** offline based on KazAST, Almaty, Abai Ave. 85, online on the CiscoWebEx platform.

Travel expenses are paid by the sender or the participant at his own expense.

**Conference languages:** Kazakh, Russian, English.

**Conditions for participation in the conference:**

- **an application** for participation indicating (online/offline), according to APPENDIX 1;
- **an article** (up to 5 pages), in electronic format, designed according to APPENDIX 2.

**Papers/ materials executed and sent without meeting the indicated requirements, or sent after the specified period, will not be accepted for printing.**

All submitted articles are refereed and then recommended for publication. By submitting the article, the author gives his consent to its publication in open access and posting on the Internet on the website of the Kazakh Academy of Sport and Tourism. As a result of the conference, a collection of conference proceedings is published in electronic PDF format.

The authors of the articles will be sent a *certificate of the participant and a collection of conference proceedings* at the end of the conference in PDF format to the e-mail addresses of the conference participants.

### **Requirements for speaking at the conference**

The report should reflect the main content of independent research. The introductory part of the report should present the purpose and problems of the study. The main part contains theoretical and practical provisions of the study. In the final part - a conclusion by the stated purpose of the study. The duration of the report is up to 10 minutes. A computer presentation is required. Conference participants answer questions from jury members and section participants.

Based on the results of the conference, a collection of scientific papers will be compiled in electronic form with subsequent posting on the Internet and on the website of the Kazakh Academy of Sport and Tourism. The organizing committee draws attention to the fact that the originality of the texts of articles must be at least 65%. Materials submitted to the conference are not reviewed and are published in the original edition. Papers that do not meet the specified requirements and have not passed the check for anti-plagiarism will not be accepted for publication.

**General requirements.** The Conference materials must be completed using the software capabilities of Microsoft Word with the extension.doc (.docx), Times New Roman font, size 14, margins 2.0 cm on all sides, paragraph indentation – 1.25 cm (paragraph indentation using the "space" and "tab" keys is not allowed), interval 1.15, text alignment in width. Sealing of intervals is prohibited.

### **Requirements for the formatting of the text of submitted materials**

The volume of the article is up to 5 pages in A4 format. Margins: top and bottom - 2 cm, left - 3 cm, right - 1 cm. Text - in a WORD text editor. Font typeface – Times New Roman. Font size: for text - 12 pt., for tables - 12 pt. Line spacing is single. The paragraph indent is 1 cm. Page numbers are not included.

The originality of the text when analyzed in the Anti-Plagiarism system is at least 65%.

Responsibility for the quality of translation into English of individual parts of the article lies with the author of the publication; the use of automatic machine and online text translators is unacceptable.

#### **Article structure**

In the first line, in the center, the title of the article is printed in capital letters, bold font (12 pt.) (in the language in which the article was written and in English).

At one interval in the center in lowercase letters, the initials and surname of the author (authors), position, name of the organization, and city are given (in the language of the article and English), font size - 12 pt.

After another interval, an abstract is presented (in the language of writing the article and in English) - no more than 100 words and keywords (in the language of writing the article and in English) - 5-7 words. The abstract should include a description of the main topic, the problem of the scientific article, the goals of the work, and its results.

Keywords. The recommended number of words is from 5 to 7 (italic font, justified, font size 12 pt) **(in the language of the article and in English).**

After another 1 interval, the text of the article is printed from the red line, justified without hyphenation; indentation - 1 cm. **The text should be highlighted in bold: introduction (relevance), purpose, objectives, research methods, research results (discussion of results), conclusions, and literature (if available).**

The text may include graphic images and tables in black and white, for which it is necessary to indicate their location in the article with links, for example - Fig. 1, Fig. 2, and Table 1 in Word format.

If necessary, **tables** (no more than two) and **figures** (no more than 1-2) can be included in the text. The text must contain references to the figures and tables provided (for example, Table 1, Figure 1).

A **bibliography** is required (5 to 7 sources), designed by GOST P 7.0.5-2008, font TimesNewRoman, font size 12. **The bibliography** is placed in alphabetical order at the end of the article.

Articles received by the organizing committee later than March 11, 2024, or that do not meet the listed requirements will not be published.
